

Match the Birds

Mix up the pictures so they are not in any particular order. Place the pictures, in a single layer, picture side down on a table.

To start the game, turn over 1 picture, identify the bird, then turn over another picture. If the 2 pictures match, set them aside, picture side up. If they do not match, return them to their spot, picture side down, on the table. Continue to turn over 1 picture at a time, identify the bird, then turn over another picture. If the 2 pictures match, set them aside. If they do not match, return them picture side down to the table. Continue until all the pictures have been matched.

If playing with others, each player takes a turn following the same pattern of turning over 1 picture, then another picture, attempting to make a match. If the player makes a match the 2 pictures are set aside & the player continues until the pictures that they turn over are not a match. At that time, the next player takes a turn.

The game ends when all the pictures are matched. The player with the most matched pictures wins.
