

Welcome Spring Suncatcher



You will need:

2 pieces of clear contact paper cut to 8 ½" x 11"

1 piece of colored construction paper size 9" x 12"

Bright colored tissue paper – several colors. Enough to cover the 8 ½" x 11" contact paper with tissue paper triangles

White glue or glue stick

Tape

To make your Welcome Spring Suncatcher, start by cutting bright colored tissue paper into various sizes of triangles. (You will need approximately 10 to 15 triangles that are about 2" to 4" in size.)

Next, cut out two 8 ½ " x 11 " rectangles of contact paper.

Now it's time to lay the tissue paper triangles strips over the contact paper rectangle. You can cover the whole area, leave gaps & overlap the colors too. There's no right or wrong way to do it. Each suncatcher will be different.

Once the colored triangles are in place, stick the second piece of contact paper over the top of the tissue paper to secure it.

Now it is time to make a frame for your suncatcher. Cut out the center of a 9" X 12" piece of construction paper. Leave about a 1" edge for the frame. Run a strip of white glue around the entire frame (on the side that will attach to the contact paper). Place the frame on top of the triangles taking care to keep the triangles centered between the edges of the frame. Press down along the sides of the frame and allow glue to dry. With tiny pieces of tape for each corner of your suncatcher, attach it to a window that lets in the most sun.
